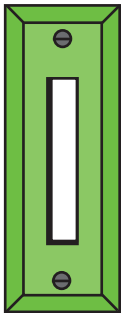

Week 2: God's Doorbell

Guess What?!

Do you have a doorbell? You do? Cool! Go push it ten times (sorry family) and then come back.

DING!
DONG!



Wasn't that cool? Now, let's say you decide to surprise a friend and go to their house. You walk up to the front door and push the doorbell. IF they are home, they greet you with a big smile and let you in (hopefully for snacks), but what if they aren't home? Then you have to turn around and go home disappointed and snackless. Our Bible verse for the week reminds us that God's door is always open. Copy it down, put it on your refrigerator or mirror for the week so it can bring JOY to everyone who sees it.

"The Lord is near to all who call on him, to all who call on him in truth." Psalm 145:18

Guess What this means for us? God is ALWAYS home and LOVES when you ring HIS doorbell! In fact, He ACTUALLY wants you to ring his doorbell all day long. (Don't try that anywhere else though...your neighbors will NOT like it.)

Do you know how to find God's doorbell? Simply talk to Him...that's called prayer. It's that simple.

Just close your eyes, bow your head, and start talking to God like He's your best friend...because HE is (only WAY better). Pray before school each day and tell Him about your day, the good stuff, the bad stuff, and everything in between. Tell Him about the people you love, ask Him for advice, or just close your eyes and feel the safety and love of His presence.
